## **MONDAY**

**Sci-Fi Club – Nick Peruzzaro**  
**Open to UE, JH, HS**

Students will explore the world of sci-fi movies and action movies. After each movie, the students will discuss the plot of the movie and the pros and cons of what they thought about the movie.

**Animated Movies Club – Tara Heitman**  
**Open to all, Max 10 students**

Over the course of this club we will look at the progression of animated movies throughout the years. Did you know they actually used to *draw* movies? From the early days of Disney to Pixar and DreamWorks, maybe even Anime! We'll watch the movies and discuss our viewpoints on the different styles of animation with the group. Students will also have input as to which films we watch each week!

**Fairy Tale Movie Club – Allison St. John**  
**Open to UE, ME, JH, HS**

Students will learn about the original tales of Sleeping Beauty, the Little Mermaid, Beauty and the Beast, and Snow White. Students will then watch movie versions of these tales and compare how the original tale has changed over time.

## **TUESDAY**

**YU GI OH CLUB – Matt Keith**  
**Open To: ME, UE, JH, HS**

This club will provide students with an opportunity to play their favorite card game in a structured environment. Students will acquire strategy and problem solving skills to use when playing the game. Math skills will develop as students calculate point totals on their way to victory. Students must bring their own cards and no trading of cards is permitted at club.

**Lego Club – James Warren**  
**Open to all, Max 10 students**

This year we are offering Lego Club to all students. We will be creating projects both individually and in groups. The children will have both free and structured time in an effort to have students work and interact together in a fun, social and creative atmosphere.

**Lego Robotics – Erik Tom**  
**Open to ME, UE, JH, HS**

Assemble and program an autonomous robot using Lego Mind-storms. Initially build stock examples and download recommended programs using a graphical user interface and flowcharting language. Build a robotic "dog" that follows its owner and barks, a marble sorting machine that recognizes colors, or a humanoid "walker" bot. Learn some fundamental computer programming concepts including flow of control, conditionals, loops, and variables. Best of all, after trying a few of the standard examples, create new robots of your own design while exploring important ideas in mechanics and mathematics!
