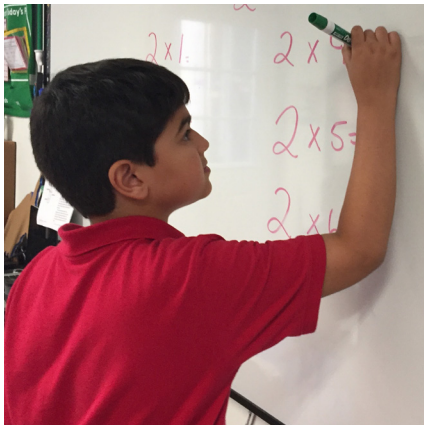

If your packet is approved, your child will be invited for a shadow day—allowing him or her to experience a full day of classes at Stanbridge. After your child has shadowed, the Head of School will discuss with you feedback from the visit.

If Stanbridge is determined an appropriate placement for your child's educational needs, you will meet by phone or in person with the Business Office regarding your financial responsibilities. You may ask any questions about financial aid at this time, a start date will be established, and an enrollment contract issued. Once the signed contract and deposit have been received, the student will then be registered as a Stanbridge Academy student.

NOTES ON TUITION

FOR ALL GRADES, TUITION AT STANBRIDGE FOR THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR IS \$41,800

Tuition includes: Day-to-day academic basics such as books, curriculum, technology, and classroom supplies; as well as speech, language, and counseling services with credentialed specialists; day trips and overnight experiential trips; student social activities; San Mateo Caltrain station shuttle; a yearbook for each student; membership to the Stanbridge Parent Association and Common Ground Speaker Series; and the cost of maintaining our low teacher-to-student classroom ratio.

Fees not included with tuition are: The afterschool and summer enrichment programs; San Francisco and South Bay commute shuttles; High School Prom; and the biennial Junior/Senior Washington, D.C. field study.
