



Stanbridge Academy Campus Visitor Policy

Updated November 2021

Stanbridge Academy has adopted the California Department of Public Health's recommendations for visitors to our campus, and has developed a Visitor Policy, the key points of which are listed below:

Stanbridge Academy requires that all visitors who are onsite at our school campus verify their Covid vaccination status.

- Visitors will be required to show an ID with photo and full name and proof of vaccination. A physical vaccination card, photo of one's vaccination card, or digital vaccination record will suffice. California residents may obtain a digital vaccination card at myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov.
 - If visitors are not vaccinated or are unable to provide the above information, they must submit a negative Covid test result administered within 72 hours of their arrival on campus.
 - Stanbridge Academy will limit nonessential visitors, volunteers, and activities involving external groups or organizations.
- Anyone, including visitors, who have symptoms of infectious illness, such as flu or Covid-19, should stay home and seek testing and care.
- All visitors are required to wear masks while on campus unless exempt.
- All visitors are required to follow other Covid safety protocols and precautions as outlined by Stanbridge Academy while on the premises.

For the purposes of touring the campus while students are present, visitors will be allowed in an open doorway for no more than 15 minutes while viewing classes. Visitors will only be allowed in the classrooms when students are not present.

Any visitor not complying with the above will be asked to reschedule to tour the campus at a later date.
